This law firm represents the defendant, Anthony Coronati, in the above-described matter before Your Honor. By Order dated January 27, 2014, the parties are required to appear tomorrow, February 6, 2014 for a conference. By this letter motion, we respectfully request an adjournment of two weeks from the original date, or a time thereafter convenient for the Court. The plaintiff, the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC"), by email dated today, February 5th, by Preethi Krishnamurthy, Esq., has informed us that it has no objection to this motion given the progress the defendant has recently shown with respect to subpoena compliance.

We acknowledge Your Honor's individual practices requiring requests for adjournments be received in Chambers at least two business days before the schedule date. In this matter, we respectfully submit that the parties have been working diligently since January 24th to address various topics, a process that has been very dynamic. We expect that an adjournment of two weeks will afford the parties sufficient time to resolve any remaining issues.
