Thomas Varnum, a partner in the Wilmington office of Brooks Pierce, has been named board chair of the Cucalorus Film Foundation. Varnum has been a member of the board for three years and served as its treasurer in 2015.

Last year’s event attracted over 17,500 directors, critics and film fanatics from all over the world to view more than 250 film selections.

Varnum is an intellectual property, entertainment and business lawyer who helped establish Brooks Pierce’s Wilmington practice in 2013. He graduated with honors from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and went on to earn his law degree from the University of California at Davis School of Law.
