

## Kearns Davis to Present Federal Criminal Case Law Update at North Carolina Bar Association Annual Review

Davis will discuss significant recent decisions by the Supreme Court of the United States and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. The presentation will be delivered in partnership with Jan E. Pritchett of Schlosser & Pritchett, who will present the annual state-law update on key recent cases from the North Carolina Supreme Court and the North Carolina Court of Appeals.

The Annual Review is designed to provide participants with the latest updates on key court decisions and significant amendments to legislation and policies covering a variety of topics and practice areas. Program highlights include updates regarding the North Carolina Business Court; criminal law; education law; environmental, energy and natural resources law; e-wills; family law; labor and employment law; and real property law.
