

## Shana Fulton and Will Quick to Present Ethics CLE for RTAC-ACC

Brooks Pierce will sponsor a "lunch-and-learn" for the Research Triangle Area Chapter (RTAC) of the Association of Corporate Counsel (ACC) on Jan. 10 at City Club Raleigh.
